THE SCHOOL DAY

At Lawford Mead Primary School the day begins with registration at 8.45am and ends at 3.15pm. Children in KS1 are provided with a healthy snack at break time. Children in KS2 can bring 20p to buy a healthy snack from the tuck trolley and any snacks they bring from home must be healthy (e.g. fruit, cereal bars, water) and not include chocolate bars, crisps or fizzy drinks. THE SCHOOL'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide children with a safe and welcoming environment, and encourage them to take care of their surroundings and each other.
- Provide the best possible education for each child.
- Encourage children to do their best at all times.
- Provide information about the curriculum being taught each term.
- Inform parents/carers of the children's progress regularly.

THE PARENT/CARER'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Ensure children arrive at school on time, 8.40am for 8.45am start.
- Ensure children's attendance is in line with or better than the national average of 96% and contact the school each day during any periods of absence.
- Ensure children have the required uniform and equipment for learning.
- Engage in children's learning, read with them daily and support the school's behaviour and homework policies.
- Attend consultation meetings to discuss child's progress.
- Attend events and performances to support children.

THE CHILD'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Demonstrate our school values in all lessons and throughout the school day.
