We hope that you enjoy using Tapestry. Here is a simple user guide to help you navigate around the software on the internet. Should you have any problems, please do not hesitate to see us.

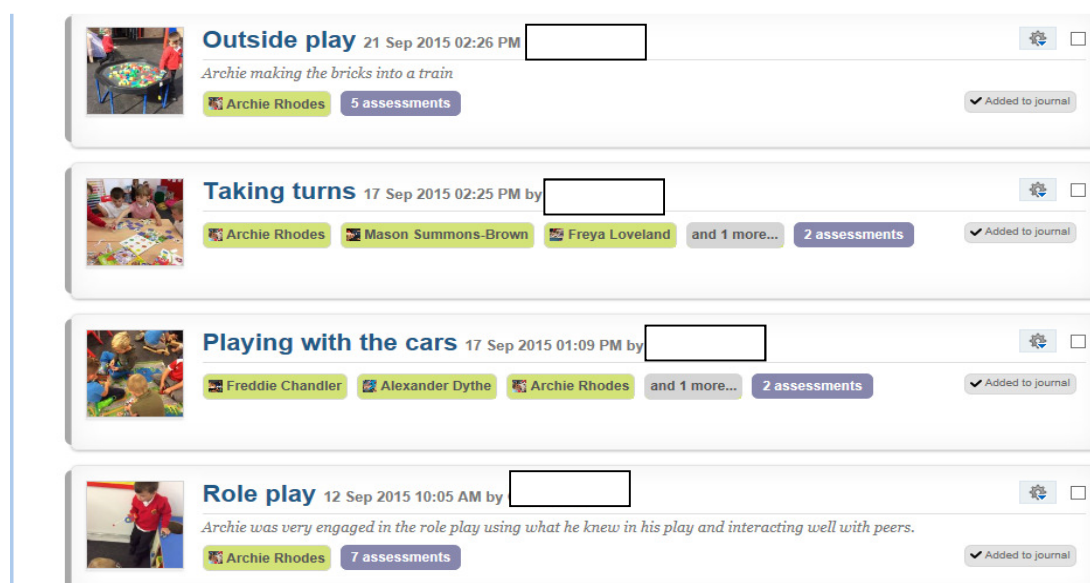
You can access your child's learning journey from the following web address:

www.eyl.j.org/login or from the app 'Tapestry' on an iphone or ipad (free to download)



You will need to log into Tapestry using your email address you provided and your password. Once you have logged into Tapestry, you will be taken to the main home page. Here you will see observations made by staff, that gives you an insight into your child's learning.

You can select an observation to view by clicking on the **Blue title** for a more detailed insight into the learning that took place.



Once you have selected an observation to view you will see something that looks like this:

Notes may also appear here that may include information about what happened, where the learning took place and what the child said.

Photo or video may be displayed here, scroll using the arrows displayed.

Information may be displayed here showing the level of development that the child displays through play. It will be linked to the EYFS curriculum

Assessments

Personal, Social and Emotional Development → Making Relationships → 40-60 months

Initiates conversations, attends to and takes account of what others say.


Communication and Language → Speaking → 40-60 months

Uses language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations.



Browse and select the files you wish to upload by selecting 'add files'. You can upload multiple files. Once you have selected all the files you wish to add click 'start upload'. You will see the files appear in the blue text box
