Reading Book Levels:

Children will have been given a Banded Book which they will be reading in school. They will bring home a book of the same band.

Opposite is a table of how the gems link to the book band colours and each phonics level.

For example if your child is Amazing Amber then they are on orange book band level, phase 6 phonics level.
